Another issue is whether the first Israelite communities practised egalitarianism, an issue taken up by Guillaume, with a response by Kletter.

The *Kybalion: A Study of the Hermetic Philosophy of Ancient Egypt and Greece* is a book originally published in 1908 by New Thought author William Walker Atkinson under the pseudonym "The Three Initiates". Coinciding with Spiritualism, New Thought, and Theosophy, the book became very popular in New Age movements, particularly with its notion of spiritual and mental alchemy. The *Kybalion* is a text which must be read with this in mind, while it is an interpretation of hermetic philosophy, it is in part still a relic of its time. Its influence cannot be understated, and the need to read it critically cannot be overstated.
